

Baseball Canberra Policy (2025) for Streaming Games

Baseball Australia is formulating a policy to address concerns that scorers across Australia have about conversations being picked up by the live streaming of games behind home plate. While this policy is being formulated, which Baseball Canberra will adopt once approved and published, our policy for the remainder of the 2024-2025 season will be as follows:

There cannot be audio attached to a live stream on any type of camera or phone camera near the area where scorers are working, behind home plate, unless there is permission from the scorers at a given game. We are not including a distance 'element' for this policy, as all audio equipment is different and instead will only allow the streaming to include streaming without audio at this time—once again, unless given approval from scorers on-site at any given game for the remainder of this season.
