Baseball Canberra Payment Policy

Effective Date: 1 July 2025

Due to an increasing number of requests for credit terms, Baseball Canberra has found it necessary to formalise its payment policy. As a small, not-for-profit organisation, we are unable to extend credit for programs, events, tournaments, or competitions, as most expenses—such as equipment, field hire, travel, staff and uniforms—are incurred in advance.

Timely payments are essential to ensure these activities can proceed smoothly for all participants.

1. Payment Terms

All fees for programs, events, tournaments, competitions and representative teams must be **paid in full prior to participation**.

In some instances, such as representative teams, a fixed payment schedule may be offered at the sole discretion of the General Manager (GM) Baseball Canberra.

Where a payment schedule is offered, **all payments must be made on or before the due dates**. Missed or late payments will result in immediate suspension from participation—including training, games, and tournaments—until the account is brought up to date.

All player fees must be **paid in full** for eligibility to participate in programs, events, competitions and tournaments.

2. Financial Responsibility

By registering in any Baseball Canberra program, team, competition, event or tournament, participants and families agree to:

- Be personally responsible for all fees, regardless of personal circumstances, injury, or withdrawal.
- Understand that **fees are non-refundable**, as most program expenses are committed in advance.
- Acknowledge that withdrawal from a program, event, tournament or team **does not cancel financial obligations**.

This policy ensures fairness, protects the viability of activities, and allows Baseball Canberra to continue delivering quality services for all participants.
