

The width and height are in the ratio of 3:2. There are five sections on the flag, the <u>taegeuk</u> and the four groups of bars (trigrams). The diameter of the <u>taegeuk</u> is half of the height of the flag. The top of the <u>taegeuk</u> is red and the bottom of the <u>taegeuk</u> is blue. The width of each trigram is the radius of the <u>taegeuk</u>. The distance between <u>taegeuk</u> and four trigrams is half of the radius of the <u>taegeuk</u>. The design of the <u>taegeuk</u>, as well as the trigrams residing in each of the four corners, are geometrically defined.
